1 General Formatting Instructions

Papers are 10 pages limited. The pages must have an overall width of $12~\rm cm$, with single column and the length of the text is $19.2~\rm cm$.

The pages must not be numbered. Paper title is centered. Authors' name are centered too. The normal text of the paper must be in 10pt. The LaTeX style file (eurofuse2004.cls) and the example file generating this page (eurofuse2004.tex), are in the Conference web page.

2 Footnotes and Citations

Footnotes must be numbered 1 , and placed at the bottom of the column where they appear.

Citations must include the reference number between brackets, for example [1]. References must be sorted by the author name.

3 Figures and Tables

All figures must be centered like Figure 1. The number and caption of the figure must always appear below the figure.
